BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a transportation services agreement with EDR Columbia, LP, d/b/a The Reserve at Columbia for expanded evening transportation services. The form and content of the agreement shall be substantially as set forth in "Exhibit A" attached hereto and made a part hereof as fully as if set forth herein verbatim.

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made as of ____ day of _____, 2013 by and between the City of Columbia, Missouri, hereinafter called the CITY, and EDR Columbia, LP, hereinafter called the PROPERTY.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the mutual covenants set out herein the parties agree as follows:

SECTION 1 - RESPONSIBILITIES OF CITY

1.1 The CITY will provide the services as described below, hereinafter called the SERVICES, consisting of the following:

a. Columbia Transit will provide transportation services via the 210 Evening Gold Route for The Reserve at Columbia. Residents of The Reserve at Columbia will have free access to the 210 Evening Gold Route for the University of Missouri Fall and Spring semester.

a.1 September 19, 2013 – December 2013 (Fall Semester)

a.2 January 2014 – May 2014 (Spring Semester).

1.2 SERVICES shall follow the posted University of Missouri semester schedule and will only be operated when the University of Missouri Shuttle Service is in operation.

1.3 SERVICES shall not be provided during scheduled holiday, summer semesters and/or semester breaks at the University of Missouri.

1.4 SERVICES shall not be provided when University of Missouri cancels classes due to weather or other unforeseen emergencies.

1.5 SERVICES are provided on a first come first serve basis for all residents. Proper bus operations and safety standards will be observed at all times.

1.6 SERVICES are provided from **11:00 PM to 1:30 AM Thursday thru Saturday; running** one complete cycle every thirty (30) minutes.

SECTION 2 - PAYMENT FOR SERVICES PROVIDED

2.1 For services performed, the PROPERTY shall pay the CITY the sum of \$2,712 for the Fall Semester and \$3,729 for the Spring Semester (as described above).

2.2 Payment is due within thirty (30) days from the date of invoice.

2.2.1 PROPERTY will be mailed an invoice at the beginning of each semester of service as described above.

2.3 Should PROPERTY fail to make payment as set out herein the CITY may suspend services immediately or at its option terminate this agreement.

SECTION 3 - GENERAL CONSIDERATIONS

3.1 Entire Agreement

This Agreement represents the entire Agreement between the PROPERTY and CITY. All previous or contemporaneous agreements, representations, promises and conditions relating to the provided service described herein are superseded.

3.2 Neither CITY nor PROPERTY shall assign, sublet, or transfer its interest in this agreement without the written consent of the other.

3.3 This Agreement is for the benefit of the parties only and not for the benefit of any third party.

3.4 If Columbia Transit does not provide all services, as provided for in the contract, for any separate five (5) days in a single semester, except for instances allowed for in the contract; the PROPERTY has the right to terminate the contract.

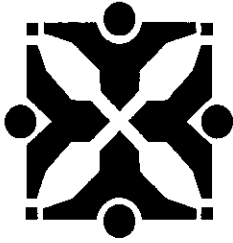

Re: Agreement with *The Reserve at Columbia* to Extend Transit Service Hours

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution authorizing an agreement with *The Reserve at Columbia* for expanded evening transportation services. The agreement would expand service hours immediately and continue through the Spring Semester.

DISCUSSION:

Columbia Transit provides public transportation service to several apartment complexes along Old 63, which cater to college students. These complexes enable their tenants to board the bus "free at the farebox," by contracting with the City. Services are only provided during the University of Missouri's fall and spring semesters. No summer service is provided.

The Reserve at Columbia currently has weekday service from 6:40 AM until 8:00 PM. In previous years, *The Reserve* and other complexes had access to the 206 Black Route for late night evening service, Thursday through Saturday. This service ended last semester with the end of the five year contract with *The Cottages*. With this agreement, a similar service would resume for services from 11:00 PM to 1:30 AM Thursday through Saturday, with a slightly altered route.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The revenue received from *The Reserve at Columbia*, for the extended hours of 11:00 PM to 1:30 AM Thursday through Saturday, will completely cover the expense to operate the route. The City will receive \$2,712 for the Fall semester and \$3,729 for the Spring semester.
