AN ORDINANCE

accepting donations from State Farm and Central Missouri Chapter CPCU to be used by the Fire Department for a fire sprinkler education program; appropriating funds; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby accepts a \$4,400.00 donation from State Farm and a \$500.00 donation from Central Missouri Chapter CPCU to be used by the Fire Department for a fire sprinkler education program.

SECTION 2. The sum of \$4,900.00 is hereby appropriated from the Miscellaneous Revenue Account No. 753-8500-480.53-23 to the General Construction Account No. 110-2342-513.11-00.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.



Re: Donation from State Farm and Central Missouri Chapter CPCU

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

This request is to accept a stipend donation from State Farm in the amount of \$4,400 and from Central Missouri Chapter CPCU in the amount of \$500 to the Columbia Fire Department for the purpose of a partnership with instructors/students at the Career Center to carry out a fire sprinkler education program.

DISCUSSION:

The Home Fire Sprinkler Coalition (HFSC) was awarded a FEMA Fire Prevention and Safety Grant, and part of their program involves awarding stipends to local fire departments who have demonstrated a commitment to public education efforts. Columbia Fire Department was chosen as a "Built for Life" Fire Department; we have been awarded a \$1,500 stipend to host a live fire and sprinkler burn demonstration. Upon completion of the program a summary report is to be provided to HFSC for evaluation purposes. The donations from State Farm and the Central Missouri Chapter CPCU will be used for a trailer and materials to assist with the live fire sprinkler burn. This donation will be used along with the donation from the Home Fire Sprinkler Coalition that was accepted in May. Materials will be purchased from FY 13 funds, the live burn is scheduled for October 4, 2013

FISCAL IMPACT:

The FY 2013 budget in fund 110 will increase by \$4,900.
