Re: Amending Chapter 4 of the City Code of Ordinances as it Relates to Alcoholic Beverages

## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

The attached ordinance amends Section 4-47 of Chapter 4 of the City Code of Ordinances as it pertains to license descriptions and fees.

## **DISCUSSION:**

The city has received a request from a business for a business license to conduct distilled spirits tastings. Current city ordinances do not include such a business license, necessitating a revision in city ordinances.

The proposed revision of Section 4-47 affixes a \$37.50 fee for a license to conduct wine, malt beverage and distilled spirit tastings on the licensed premises to persons licensed to sell intoxicating liquor in the original package at retail under Sections 4-47(8) and 4-47(9). This recommended change is consistent with Section 311.294 of the State of Missouri Liquor Control Law.

Revenue of \$37.50 per license issued.
