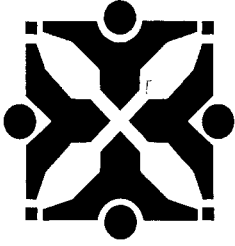

Re: Share the Light Appropriation

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Share the Light program began in August 2001 as a way for residents to contribute to City of Columbia projects through their utility bill on a one-time or monthly basis. As of November 21, 2013, more than \$199,000 has been raised for six areas of city programming. Staff is requesting appropriation of funds for use by the Office of Cultural Affairs.

DISCUSSION:

The Share the Light program allows Columbia residents to contribute to one or more of six areas of city programming that extend beyond basic City services. The six areas are community arts programming, community beautification, youth recreation scholarships, public health, fire prevention, and education and crime prevention. Since Share the Light started, more than \$164,000 has been appropriated (including this request) throughout all six program components.

Staff is asking that \$633 in Share the Light funds be appropriated for the following 2 community arts programs through the Office of Cultural Affairs and overseen by OCA Director J.J. Musgrove:

1. The first project, \$300, will be led by local artist David Spear. It will marry two art styles and allow students at Fun City Youth Academy (Columbia Playground, Inc.), which meets at the Blind Boone Center, to experiment with colors and motion to explore artistic expression. A public showing of the work will be scheduled in the spring. The allocation will purchase art supplies for the project.
2. The second project, \$333, is for materials to support creation of a mural at Tree Tops Learning Day Care Project. Tree Tops is a day care center which seeks to care for under-served children in Columbia. The mural project will be completed by local artists who donate time and talent to create a wall that is indicative of reading, learning, and exploring the larger world.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Share the Light funds are donated by the public. Through these funds, departments are able to provide services and programs that may not otherwise be offered.
