SERVICE AGREEMENT AMENDMENT
BETWEEN
CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI
AND
CENTRO LATINO de SALUD

The City of Columbia, Missouri (hereinafter "City) and the Centro Latino de Salud enter into this Amendment to the existing Service Agreement to define the responsibilities of each party in implementing Grant 11-0264-HLD-11, the Health Literacy Project Expansion and Replication Grant funded by Missouri Foundation for Health.

Period of Agreement: November 1, 2011 to June 30, 2014.

The Centro Latino de Salud agrees to:

- A. Provide staff for health literacy promotion services and education as described in the proposal.
- B. Provide an onsite facility for conducting project-related activities.
- C. Oversee interns and volunteers assigned to Centro de Salud components of the project.
- D. Recruit First Ward residents for health promotion activities, distributing follow-up surveys, and otherwise assist in contacting participants for follow-up surveys.
- E. Organize events that relate to nutrition and physical activity as part of general support for health literacy programming.
- F. Purchase materials, supplies and incentives to accomplish the above projects.
- G. Attend collaborative meetings called by CBCPHHS relating to this project.
- H. Submit invoices for expenses identified in the project description.
- I. Provide information required for reports at dates compliant with the MFH requirements.

City of Columbia (CBCPHHS) agrees to:

- A. Serve as project fiscal agent, compile all reports to Missouri Foundation for Health, facilitate collaborative meetings of partners, and coordinate evaluation.
- B. Serve as contact for the project to Missouri Foundation for Health.
- C. Offer the use of CBCPHHS training room, if needed.
- D. CBCPHHS will disburse a total of \$192,218 over the project term as payment for salaries and supplies, in compliance with MFH project schedule.

 - c. \$44,064 November, 2012
 - d. \$44,065 May, 2013
 - e. \$10,000 June 2014



EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

A resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign an amendment to the Service Agreement between the City of Columbia and Centro Latino de Salud. This amendment extends the agreement period to June 2014.

DISCUSSION:

The Missouri Foundation for Health (MFFH) has granted a six month, no cost extension for the existing Agreement 11-0264-HDL-11 to allow for complete expenditure of grant funds. This contract is a partnership between the City of Columbia and Centro Latino de Salud y Educacion for the provision of community based health education related to obesity prevention and diabetes control.
