Re: Amending Chapter 14 to add Parking Meters on the East Side of Orr Street

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Staff has prepared for Council consideration legislation amending Chapter 14 of the City Code to install three (3) 2-hour parking meters on the east side of Orr Street, between Ash Street and Park Avenue, as part of the Bike Boulevard project.

DISCUSSION:

At the October 7, 2013 Council meeting, staff submitted a report to Council addressing concerns raised at the September 3, 2013 public hearing concerning the loss of parking spaces related to the Bike Boulevard project, from the Wabash Station to Hominy Trail. Council approved staff's modification to remove one parking space on Orr Street in front of the fire station, and one parking space on Ash Street, to improve safety for the proposed all-way stop at the intersection of Orr and Ash streets. In addition, three (3) new 2-hour parking spaces will be added on the east side of Orr Street, between Ash Street and Park Avenue, adjacent to the current Ameren facility. Construction of this GetAbout project will begin once Ameren completes the remediation of their facility on Orr Street, proposed for late August of 2014.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The removal and installation of the parking meters will be completed by the Parking Utility staff.
