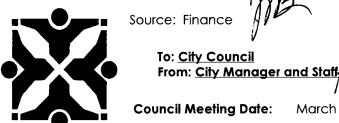

# **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance appropriating funds for Emergency Management Services.

# **DISCUSSION:**

During the FY 2014 budget process the City budgeted for payments to Boone County Fire Protection District (BCFPD) for emergency management services that they would provide to the City for October thru December 2013. Beginning in January 2014 these services will be paid by the County and funded by the new 911 tax.

The latest invoice received causes the amount owed the BCFPD to exceed the budgeted amount by \$35,241, which includes \$16,474.35 in siren upgrades that the City did not anticipate when preparing the FY 2014 budget. Therefore, an appropriation is needed to pay the BCFPD for these expenditures.

### FISCAL IMPACT:

The cost for BCFPD services and siren upgrades exceeding the budgeted amount is \$35,241.
