#### **Collection History**

Early 1970's went from trash cans to bags

Added yard waste and recycling bags, 1991 and 1998 respectively

Service has unlimited quantity collection

 Items are manually collected now with two man rear loaders

## **Collection Vehicles**



### Advantages

Can be implemented with no rate increase

It is essentially a pay as you throw system (PAYT)

Automated trucks mean employees may be able to work longer hours or for more years

 Alternative energy like compressed natural gas (CNG) to replace diesel powered vehicles Advantages (continued)
Workers compensation insurance is reduced
Animals getting into bags and scattering trash will be eliminated

Service tracking and customer notification are features that could be implemented

 Flexible future scheduling is possible, e.g. 4-ten hour days

Work can be performed during weather extremes heat and cold

### Disadvantages

Carts may remain at the curb

Bulky items will not fit into carts

Carts will be lost or stolen

 Yard waste collection is more difficult when considering placing limbs in roll carts and seasonal quantities of items such as grass and leaves Disadvantages (continued)Curbside parking could be an issue

Landfill is only approved to accept yard waste for a total of 12 years

Residents will continue to use bags they purchase in addition to roll carts

Carts get dirty and need to be cleaned (health dept./sanitation issue?)

#### Financials

Capital cost to implement \$5,860,000

Current monthly fee is \$15.42

FY 2011 residential trash only monthly collection cost was \$9.18

Estimated trash only roll cart monthly cost would be \$8.30

 Lease or lease purchase options are available

 Trucks or carts can be leased together or separately
