ROCK QUARRY ROAD SCENIC ROADWAY STAKEHOLDER ADVISORY GROUP: Up to 10 potential vacancies. Up to five members shall be residents who live along the affected scenic road corridor, which is the portion of Rock Quarry Road from the south property line of the property located at the southwest corner of Fellows Place to the south city limits of Columbia, and one of those members must be a resident property owner.
