Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution granting a waiver of the open container ordinance and approval for the annual Harvest Hootenanny event.

Discussion

Billy Polansky is requesting a waiver of the open container ordinance for Smith Street between College Avenue and Fay Street beginning October 4th, 2014, 3:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m., to hold the annual Harvest Hootenanny fundraising event.

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby grants a temporary waiver from the requirements of Section 16-185 of the City Code so that the possession of an open container of alcohol and consumption of an alcoholic beverage shall be allowed on October 4, 2014 from 3:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. for the area along a portion of Smith Street between College Avenue and Fay Street during the Harvest Hootenanny fundraising event.
