AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into this	day of	, 2013, by and between
the City of Columbia, Missouri (hereinafter City), and Midwest	Sports Productions (hereinafter
Contractor).		

City and Contractor agree as follows:

- 1. The Contractor shall provide the services outlined in its proposal for Sports Development Funds for the Tiger Classic Youth Basketball Tournament, as submitted to the City's Convention and Visitors Bureau, a copy of which is on file in that office, at a cost to the City of \$14,500 (Fourteen Thousand Five Hundred Dollars) in connection with the performance of the services to be provided under the agreement, the Contractor agrees to comply with all civil rights laws, and further agrees not to discriminate against any individual or segment of the community on the basis of sex, race, color, age, religion, creed, national origin, veteran, disability status or sexual orientation.
- 2. Contractor agrees that it is responsible for all funds made available to Contractor by this Agreement and further agrees that it will reimburse to the City any funds expended in violation of city, state, or federal law or in violation of this agreement.
- 3. Contractor agrees that it will make no changes in the approved Project until the changes are approved in writing by the City.
- 4. Contractor agrees that it is subject to audit and review on request by the City. If contractor has a financial audit prepared, that report shall be furnished to the City's Convention and Visitors Bureau.
- 5. Contractor agrees that all funds received from the City will be expended as approved by City Council and none of the funds shall be diverted to any other use or purpose, except as recommended by the Convention & Visitors Bureau's Advisory Board and as approved by the City Council. Full records of all expenditures and disbursements and any income from the provision of the program described in Contractor's proposal shall be kept and open to City inspection during regular business hours.
- 6. Contractor agrees to provide the Convention and Visitors Bureau with copies of all financial documentation no later than 90 days following the last day of the funded event, as outlined in the Post-Event Documentation Procedures. Documentation must include copies of checks issued for payment of services or items, copies of corresponding invoices and copies of any required contracts. If Contractor does not provide financial documentation, they may not be eligible for future funding.
- 7. Contractor agrees that the Convention and Visitors Bureau and the City will be recognized as outlined in the Contractor's proposal.

Resolution Authorizing Tourism Development Funds and Authorizing the City Manager to Execute Agreement

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Midwest Sports Productions submitted a Sports Development Fund (SDF) application for the "Tiger Classic" youth basketball tournament. They requested \$14,500 to assist with tournament site fees, officials and awards.

DISCUSSION:

The "Tiger Classic" will be held January 11-13, 2013 at the University of MO Rec Center. It is the third stop in MSP's Campus Tour tournament which also includes KU and UMKC.

In 2012, approximately 60 teams participated. We are anticipating approximately 80 teams, comprised of boys and girls teams, 3rd through 8th grades. Each team is guaranteed four to five games over three days.

This will be the third year this event is held in Columbia. It generates over 500 hotel room nights during a time of low occupancy.

The Convention & Visitors Bureau Advisory Board reviewed the application at their November 29th meeting and voted unanimously to recommend the application be approved for full funding, or \$14,500.

FISCAL IMPACT:

\$14,500. The funds are appropriated in the FY13 CVB budget.
