#### AN ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council finds and determines that a certain sewer easement on Lot 20 within Centerstate, Plat 1 located at the southeast corner of Vandiver Drive and Lake Ridgeway Road, more particularly described as follows:

A strip of land twenty (20) feet in width being part of the Grant of Easement for Sewer Purposes as recorded in Book 360 at Page 430, said part being across Lot 20 of Centerstate Plat 1 as recorded in Plat Book 35 at Page 33, both of the Boone County Records; situate in the City of Columbia, Boone County, Missouri; said strip being ten (10) feet in width on both sides of the following described centerline:

Starting at the center of Section 5, Township 48 North, Range 12 West (also being the southeast corner of said Lot 20); thence along the north-south quarter (1/4) section line, said line also being the east line of said Lot 20, N.0°52'E., 153.8 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING; thence leaving said line N.13°53'W., 42.75 feet; thence N.71°18'W., 241.0 feet; thence N.21°33'W., 161.4 feet; thence N.3°09'W., 199.29 feet to the END on the south Right-of-Way line of Vandiver Drive.


