Forfeiture Funds Appropriation

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance authorizing the appropriation of \$16,012.00 from the Asset Forfeiture Funds to Police Admin Support (budget) for the purchase of SWAT Communication Headsets.

DISCUSSION:

The current headsets used by SWAT officers were purchased sometime prior to 1997 and are outdated and in such a state of disrepair that most of the team operates without any sort of headset at all. In addition to being surpassed by the normal technology the headsets have been kept in service beyond a reasonable life expectancy.

The SWAT officers have the need to hear radio traffic clearly and to work as close to hands free as possible. With the headsets in the current state of disrepair, the officers are having to use a handheld portable to communicate, creating a unfavorable situation. The replacement headsets the Police are seeking will not only replace the function of the old ones, but will allow for hands free communication, hearing enhancement, and protection for the operators.

Replacement of the headsets was originally placed in the Supplemental request for FY13, however they were pulled off by Police and Budget in order to meet FY13 budget constraints with the anticipation of using the Federal Forfeiture fund account to make the purchase.
