## AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES

Section 2 is amended to expand the Scope of Services to include the following:

- Field and laboratory concrete testing for decks, columns, walls and slabs on grade
- Concrete reinforcement observations
- Post-tension tendon stressing observations
- Precast panel connection observations

Section 6 is amended to replace subsection 6.1.2 with the following:

6.1.2. Total payment for the Scope of Services as described in this Amendment shall not exceed \$85,000.00 Total compensation under this Agreement **shall not exceed \$170,000.00**.

All other provisions of the September 18, 2012 agreement shall remain in effect.

#### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution authorizing an amendment to the agreement with Engineering Surveys and Services for construction inspection services related to the construction of the Short Street Parking Garage project.

#### DISCUSSION:

At the September 17, 2012 Council meeting, an agreement with Engineering Surveys and Services was adopted by Council for construction inspection services for the Short Street parking garage project. The agreement contemplated the substructure quality assurance testing and observations including the geopier installation (515 geopiers); parking garage footings; column embeds and foundation; Northlight footings; pilasters with anchor bolts; column embeds and foundation; utility installations; alley paving and soil compaction. This amendment continues quality assurance testing and observations needed for the superstructure that includes field and laboratory concrete testing for decks, columns, walls and slabs; concrete rebar and cable observations; post-tension tendon stressing observations and; precast panel connection observations.

#### FISCAL IMPACT:

The original contract amount was \$85,000 and was paid from the Short Street parking garage project. The amendment is also estimated at \$85,000, for a total not to exceed amount of \$170,000.00. No additional funds will need to be appropriated.
