ADOPT A SPOT AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into this _____ day of _____, 2013, between the City of Columbia, Missouri, a municipal corporation ("City"), and the Columbia Housing Authority ("Adopter").

The parties agree as follows:

1. Adopter shall maintain planting beds located in the median of Providence Road between Park Avenue and Worley Street/Rogers Street.
2. Adopter shall maintain the planting beds for a period of four years from the date of this agreement. Maintenance of the planting bed shall include but not be limited to weeding, watering, mulching and planting annual flowers and bulbs.
3. The City will provide a sign in the bed recognizing the Adopter's efforts. The cost of a new sign required because of an Adopter name change will be paid by the Adopter.
4. City may terminate this agreement if adopter fails to maintain the planting bed.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Parties hereto have executed this Agreement on the day and year first above written.








Re: Adopt-A-Spot Beautification Agreements

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Volunteer Programs is submitting for approval and Adopt-A-Spot Beautification agreement with the Columbia Housing Authority to care for landscaping in the Providence Road median between Park Avenue and Rogers/Worley.

DISCUSSION:

Volunteers maintain more than 90 landscaped beds in city or state right of way in the City of Columbia. Adopters are responsible for weeding, watering, and mulching the beds and planting annual flowers and bulbs. Agreements are written for a four-year commitment and each bed has a sign to acknowledge the efforts of the adopter.

Staff is submitting an Adopt-A-Spot Agreement with the Columbia Housing Authority (CHA) to care for the planting areas in the median of the Providence Road between Park Avenue and Rogers/Worley. CHA is working with the Columbia Center for Urban Agriculture to install and maintain the landscaping. Their proposed plant materials include prairie dropseed, purple poppy mallow, Missouri primrose and glade coneflower. CHA is also working with City staff to have a drip irrigation system with a timer installed that will assist in maintaining the landscaping in a safer manner than manual watering.

The City's Volunteer Programs staff appreciates the investment that volunteers put into Adopt-A-Spot beds to be enjoyed by hundreds of residents and visitors each day.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The City will assist with ongoing support by providing mulch, bulbs, annual flowers, and replacement plants as needed. The City will pay for a sign to acknowledge the work of CHA at a cost of \$130. Labor, which is the largest expense in maintaining the beds, will be provided by adopter.

As an Adopt-A-Spot Beautification Partner, I understand that:


- My commitment as a volunteer plays an important role in our community. My work will be seen by hundreds of citizens and visitors each day and will affect their perception of Columbia.
- The expectation for my Adopt-A-Spot bed is for it to be weed-free and to have color throughout the growing season.
- It is my responsibility to maintain the bed through weeding, watering, mulching and planting annual flowers and bulbs. Maintenance requires on-going care from me, with an investment of time each week or every-other-week during the growing season.
- I will keep safety in mind when working in the bed taking care around traffic and may request the use of safety vests.
- I need to be in touch with the City of Columbia Volunteer Programs if my sign is damaged, I need technical advice, help with replacement plants, repairs to the water hydrant in my bed, or to update the contact information for myself or my group.
- I will properly dispose of the plant waste and weeds produced in my bed by hauling it away or bagging it and asking that it be picked up.
- I will be asked to provide a record of volunteer hours given to this bed by myself and my group a few times each year. These volunteer hours help the city measure the activities of the program.

The City of Columbia will:

- Provide a sign in recognition for your efforts.
- Provide feedback to you on your bed – both praise on a “job well done” or ideas for improvement.
- Communicate any comments received on your bed from the public.
- Provide information of assistance to adopters through newsletters, e-mail and educational meetings.
- Provide safety equipment (vests and signs) as requested by the adopter.
- Make you aware of any resources available for your bed, including mulch, bulbs, perennials and annual flowers.
- Make an effort to accommodate the needs of you, our volunteer adopter.
