Re: Street Closure Request - Fourth of July Celebration

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The City Manager's Office has received a street closure request for the Fourth of July Celebration being held in downtown Columbia.

DISCUSSION:

The Parks and Recreation Department has requested the following street closures for the Fourth of July Celebration on July 4, 2013.

4th Street, from Cherry to Locust, 3pm until 10pm;

5th and 6th, from Cherry to midway between Locust and Elm,
Cherry, from 5th to 6th, with a diagonal closure to allow for traffic flow; and,
Locust, from Providence to just east of 6th - at entrance to the Hinkel Lot from 7:30 p.m. until 10:00 p.m. or until area is determined clear following the fireworks show.

CID reviewed and approved the street closure at their April 9 Board meeting. The Special Event Committee recommends approval as well.

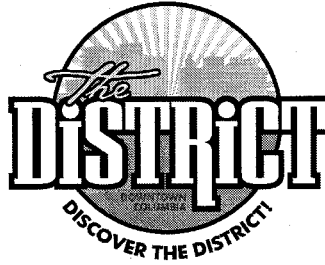

61st Annual - 4th of July Fire in the Sky

Proposed street closures for events held at Flat Branch Park and for fireworks safety zone.

Hard closure from 3 pm to 10 pm on July 4, 2013

4th Street from Cherry to Locust for children's activities and entertainment at Flat Branch Park.

Soft closure from 7:30 pm to 10:00 pm or after all clear from fireworks show. Barricades will be monitored and traffic allowed to leave lots at Flat Branch Pub and other businesses except during fireworks show.

5th and 6th from Cherry to midway between Locust and Elm and
Cherry from 5th to 6th with diagonal closure to allow for traffic flow and
Locust from Providence to just east of 6th – at entrance to Hinkel lot.

There will be no parking in the 6th and Cherry garage beginning at 8 am on July 4 and will open again at 10:30 pm.

There will be "no parking signs" on meters indicating that there will be no parking on any of the streets proposed for closure or parking lot west of 6th and Cherry garage after 5 pm on July 4.
