A RESOLUTION

declaring the necessity for construction of sidewalks on the east side of Fairview Road from Highland Drive to West Broadway; stating the nature of and the estimate of the cost of the improvement; providing for payment for the improvement; providing for compliance with the prevailing wage law; and setting a public hearing.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council deems the construction of a six-foot wide sidewalk on the east side of Fairview Road from Highland Drive to West Broadway, the reconstruction of two driveways to meet ADA requirements and other miscellaneous work, all in accordance with the City of Columbia Street and Storm Sewer Specifications and Standards, more specifically described as the Fairview Road Sidewalk Project, necessary to the welfare and improvement of the City.

SECTION 2. The nature and scope of the improvement shall consist of furnishing all labor, materials, transportation, insurance and all other items, accessories and incidentals thereto necessary for the complete construction of the improvements.

SECTION 3. The estimated cost of this improvement is \$152,900.00.

SECTION 4. Payment for this improvement shall be made from Non-Motorized Transportation Funds and such other funds as may be lawfully appropriated.

SECTION 5. Any work done in connection with the construction of the improvement specified above shall be in compliance with the provisions of the prevailing wage laws of the State of Missouri. The City shall also cause to be inserted into the contract a stipulation that all laborers and mechanics employed by the contractor or subcontractors in the performance of work under the contract shall be paid wages at rates not less than those prevailing on similar construction in the locality as determined by the Secretary of Labor in accordance with the Davis-Bacon Act.

SECTION 6. A public hearing in respect to this improvement will be held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall Building, 701 E. Broadway, Columbia, Missouri, at 7:00 p.m. on July 1, 2013. The City Clerk shall cause notice of this hearing to be published in a newspaper published in the City.

Re: Public Hearing - Fairview Road Sidewalk

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution setting a public hearing for July 1, 2013, for the construction of sidewalk improvements on the east side of Fairview Road, from Highland Drive to West Broadway, as shown on the attached location map. An Interested Parties meeting for Fairview Road Sidewalk Project was held April 23, 2013.

DISCUSSION:

The Fairview Road Sidewalk project, from Highland Drive to West Broadway, is part of the Non-Motorized Transportation (GetAbout) program. Preliminary design of this project was completed under original GetAbout Phase I funding. The project includes construction of a 6-feet wide sidewalk at the back of the curb on the east side of Fairview Road from Highland Drive to West Broadway. The concept includes approximately 1,100 linear feet of sidewalk and reconstruction of two driveways to meet ADA requirements. Staff anticipates approximately 13 trees will need to be removed in order to construct the project. Current preliminary typical section and plan view diagrams are attached. Staff anticipates construction to be completed by the end of 2014. The current project cost estimate is \$152,900.

An Interested Parties (IP) meeting was held for this project in May 2008, and attendees were generally supportive. A second IP meeting was held April 23, 2013, due to the amount of time that passed since the initial meeting. Ten (10) people signed in at the meeting, and everyone in attendance was supportive of the project. One (1) written comment was received and is attached.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The project cost estimate is \$152,900, and will be paid from Non-Motorized Transportation grant funds. To date, \$30,580 has been appropriated to this project account.
