A RESOLUTION

authorizing the temporary closure of a portion of South Sixth Street between Elm Street and East Stewart Road to allow for emergency repair of the Loeb Courtyard steam distribution and potable water system.

WHEREAS, the University of Missouri has requested permission of the City to temporarily close a portion of South Sixth Street between Elm Street and East Stewart Road to allow for emergency repair of the Loeb Courtyard steam distribution and potable water system.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the University of Missouri to temporarily close a portion of South Sixth Street between Elm Street and East Stewart Road, as shown on "Exhibit A," from June 10, 2013 to August 5, 2013 for emergency repair of the Loeb Courtyard steam distribution and potable water system.

SECTION 2. The University of Missouri shall close the street only in accordance with the traffic control plan submitted and approved by the City's Director of Public Works. The University of Missouri shall be responsible for all signs and barricades necessary for the protection and convenience of the general public. The University of Missouri shall be responsible for notifications to the media and emergency personnel.

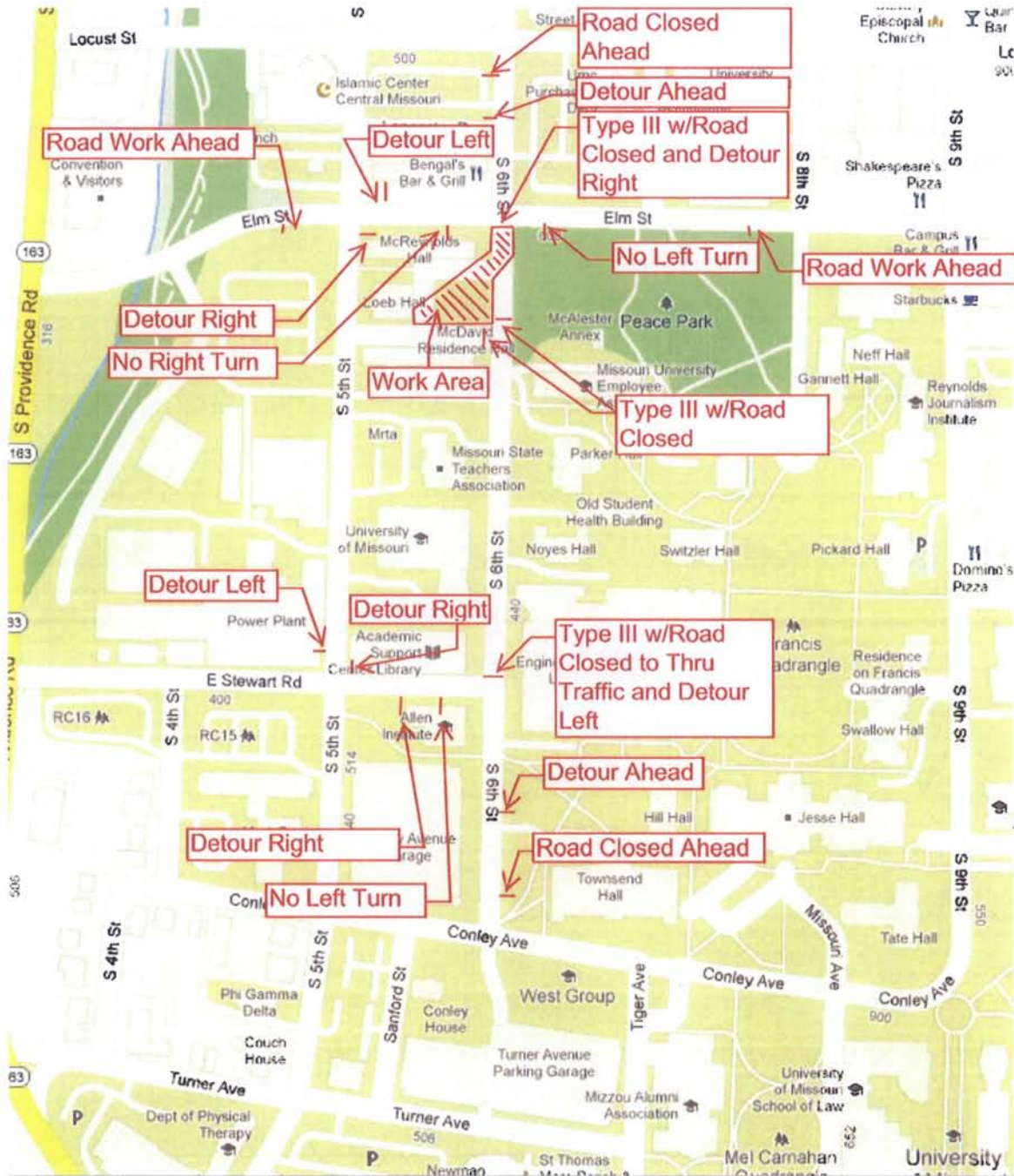
Boone County Internet Parcel Map

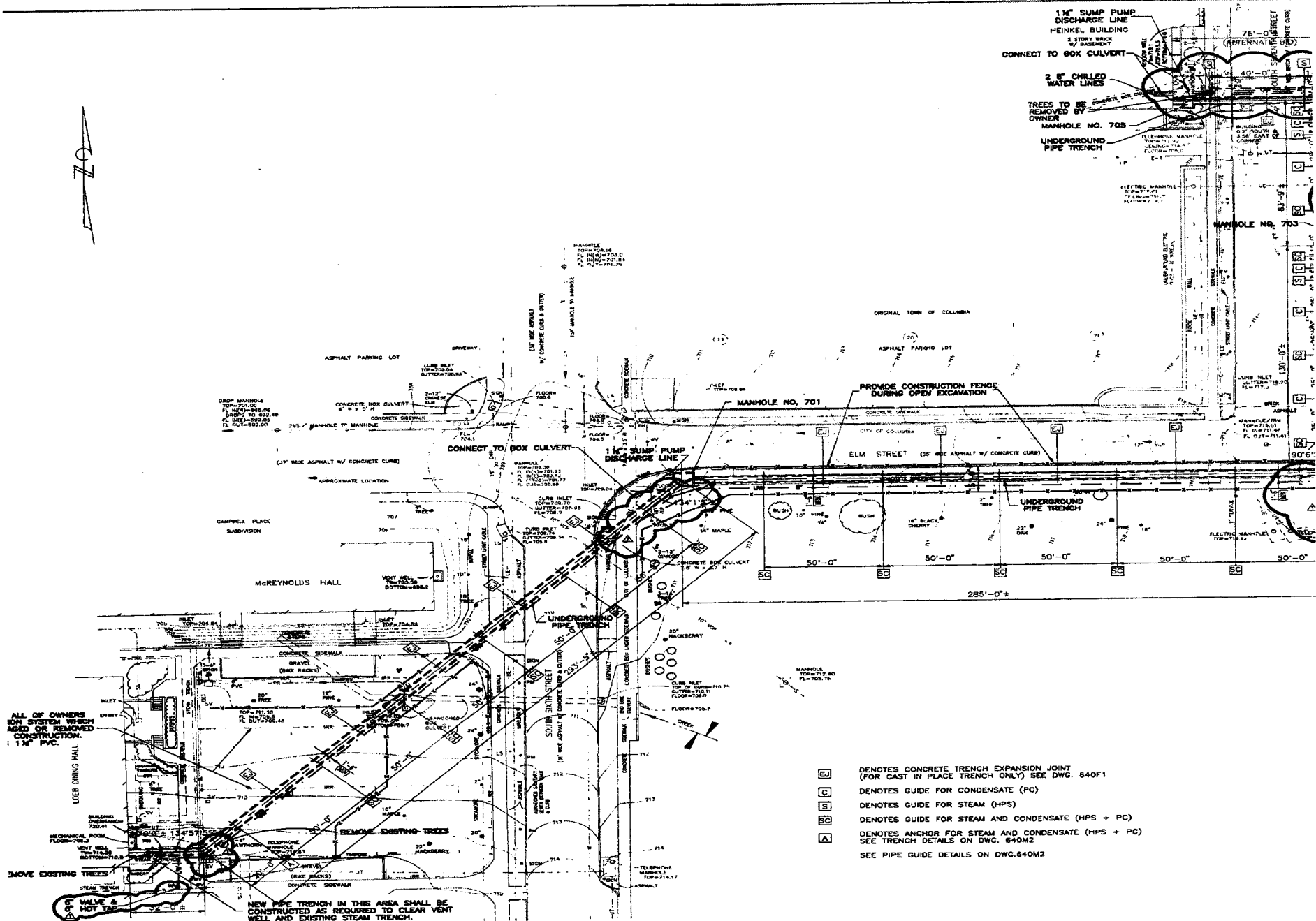

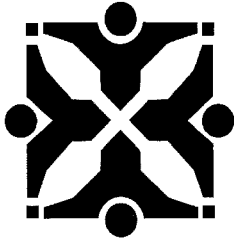

Re: Allowing the University of Missouri to Temporarily Close S. Sixth Street between Elm Street and E. Stewart Road

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution authorizing the University of Missouri to temporarily close S. Sixth Street, between Elm Street and E. Stewart Road, to allow for the emergency repair of the Loeb Courtyard steam distribution and potable water system.

DISCUSSION:

The University of Missouri is seeking permission to temporarily close S. Sixth Street from Elm Street to approximately 600 feet to the south. The urgent scope of this project is to repair a recently failed eight inch water line, and steam and condensate lines, in a concrete chase damaged by the ruptured water line flooding the steam chase. Additionally, the utility work will close the adjacent sidewalk along Sixth Street. The repair will likely begin on June 10th, and completed by August 5, 2013.

Staff has reviewed and approved the attached traffic control plan. The University of Missouri shall be responsible for all signs and barricades necessary for the protection and convenience of the general public, and shall be responsible for notifications to the media and emergency personnel.
