THE SUBJECT CONTRACT BETWEEN THE STATE OF MISSOURI, DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND SENIOR SERVICES AND
 Columbia/Boone County Health Department

IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

The Department of Health and Senior Services hereby exercises its option to amend this contract due to changes with the upcoming new grant cycle concerning follow up billing per the SMHW Provider Manual Billing Guidelines for the contract period of June 1, 2013 through June 29, 2013. The total contract amount will stay the same and shall be available for the contract period of July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013.

1. Delete Section 1.1 in its entirety and replace with revised Section 1.1:

- 1.1 Provide breast and cervical cancer screening and diagnostic services to Show Me Healthy Women (SMHW) program eligible clients. Provide diagnostic testing and lifestyle education to clients enrolled in the Well-Integrated Screening and Evaluation for Women Across the Nation (WISEWOMAN) program.

2. Delete Section 2.2 in its entirety and replace with revised Section 2.2:

- 2.2 Services authorized, and resulting charges, are subject to review and approval by the Department. Payments for services shall be in accordance with manual guidelines in effect at the time services are provided. The Department exercises its option to omit cardiovascular screening services during the time period from June 1, 2013 to June 29, 2013. No continuing or follow-up services will be allowed after June 29, 2013 for clients screened prior to July 1, 2013.

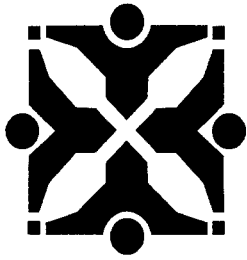
3. Add Section 2.2 a. in its entirety and replace with revised Section 2.2 a.:

- 2.2 a Screening services not allowed as listed in the SMHW – WISEWOMAN Provider Manual are CPT Codes: 99420W - initial screening, 99420WA – annual screening, 99201A – non-integrated initial screening, 99212W – non-integrated annual screening office visit, 82465(W) – Total Cholesterol 83718 (W) – HDL Cholesterol, 83036A – A1C. Only lab work performed as delayed within 30 days of previous screening office visit or as a second follow-up lab will be reimbursed.

All other terms and conditions of the contract, or any amendments thereto, shall remain unchanged.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

A resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign Amendment 002 to Contract ERS16113075 for the Show Me Healthy Women (SMHW) Program between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health & Senior Services. This amendment revises specific sections of the scope of work. Total contract amount not to exceed \$18,000 and the contract period of July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013 remain the same.

DISCUSSION:

This contract provides funding for the provision of cardiovascular screening and breast and cervical cancer screening as well as related education for low income, uninsured women. The funding also covers the cost for clinical exams and lab tests provided to eligible women and is a cost-reimbursement contract. This amendment revises specific sections of the scope of work including allowing the Department of Health & Senior Services the option to omit cardiovascular screening services during the period from June 1, 2013 to June 29, 2013.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Funding was anticipated in the FY2013 budget process. Contract amount remains the same.
