Donation Appropriation - Beulah Ralph memorial plaza as part of the Douglass High School Infrastructure improvement project

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Parks and Recreation Department is requesting Council action to appropriate donated funds in the amount of \$10,700 for the Beulah Ralph memorial plaza as part of the improvements to the front of Douglass High School. Council previously approved the Douglass Park and High School project at their May 6, 2013 meeting.

DISCUSSION:

Beulah Ralph worked for the Columbia Public School District for 58 years and helped the District convert from the Jim Crow period of segregation by developing the District's home-school communicator program. As part of the improvements to the Douglass Park and High School, the District and the Parks and Recreation Department agreed with citizen input that a memorial to recognize Ms. Ralph's contribution is appropriate for the the front of Douglass High School. The memorial will also be included as part of the African American Heritage/Civil Rights Trail. Fund raising is complete with the \$10,700 received in donations. Staff is requesting Council approval to appropriate the funds so that work can begin. The Beulah Ralph memorial plaza will include a small paver patio, memorial plaque and two benches as a memorial to the Douglass High School career of Mrs. Ralph.

FISCAL IMPACT:

No fiscal impact. The memorial is located on Columbia Public School District property and will be maintained by the District.
