EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The City Manager's Office has received four street closure requests.

DISCUSSION:

Tommy Saunders has requested the closure of Tenth Street, from Broadway to Cherry Street, on June 20 from 7:00 p.m. until 8:30 p.m.

Richard King has requested the closure of Ninth Street, from Walnut to Broadway, from 8am until midnight, on July 12, July 24, and August 16 for Summerfest Events. He is also requesting waiver of the open container from 6pm until midnight for all three events.

The Special Event Committee and the CID have reviewed and approved these four requests.
